

First Aid Course - Information Sheet

- Course Description:** This course will assist participants in both identifying and eliminating potentially hazardous conditions in the environment, be able to recognize emergencies and make suitable decisions for first aid care. Participants will acquire the skills required to be able to assist and provide immediate care for a suddenly ill or seriously injured person.
- Course Length:** 1 day on campus. Plus, study and completion of quizzes at home prior to the course.
- Mode of Study:** Full Time
- Hours:** 9am-2.30pm
- Commencement:** Speak to administration about available booking dates
- Course Cost:** \$85
- Payment Options:** Full payment must be paid to book

- Pre-requisites:** English to a "Pre-intermediate" level + Completion of Year 10 (Australia), or equivalent. Students will be given access to the Online Learning Centre, course resources and First Aid Quizzes before their booking date. Students are expected to complete all 6 quizzes before attending their booked class. It is important to note that the HLTAID competency standards do require a level of physical ability to meet the evidence requirements for assessment. These standards relate to the level of performance required to provide resuscitation and respond to an emergency situation where there may be risk to life. Due to the potential risk to health and safety where a nominated first aider, or worker with duty of care, does not have the ability to perform resuscitation and/or first aid to the performance standard it is not appropriate to issue a statement of attainment to students who are physically unable to meet the assessment requirements.
- Inclusions:** This course is available at Brisbane and Gold Coast locations. More courses and campus information can be found on the All Course and Campus Quick Guide. The fees include everything that students require to complete the qualification, including administration fees and texts.
- Student Rights:** You have rights with regards to refunds, complaints and appeal processes. - Minimum class size:** 8 bookings required for the class to go ahead. If the minimum number is not reached within 48 hours of the booking time the class will be rescheduled or a full refund will be issued.
